Membership- This involves picking up membership forms/payments from the Athletic office at North throughout the summer and generating a computer file of members.

Coach Appreciation Breakfast- Planning and setting up the breakfast for our coaching staff early one morning in October. Volunteers to bake are always welcome!

Indoor Concession Coordinator(s)- This individual/committee will organize the Winter lottery for all interested qualifying Umbrella Clubs. The indoor concession is open for all home basketball and wrestling events. It is also open for special Fencing events, as well as special events offered by the Athletic Dept.. Events being run solely by the NHHS BC would require recruiting the necessary Booster Club volunteers as well.

Spring Plant Sale- Many volunteers are needed to work this 2 day event usually held Mother's Day Weekend. A Chairperson is needed to coordinate the volunteers as well as organize the event directly with our local plant wholesaler.

Senior Scholarships- Volunteers are needed to oversee the voting of the Senior class for the Most Spirited Awards, and the Varsity players of every team for the Team scholarships. Voting is conducted during the lunch mods over a 3 or 4 day period 3 weeks before the Senior Athlete banquet.
