COURSE DESCRIPTIONS**HIGH SCHOOL****ENGLISH I (SUM 001)**

Course includes the basic skills of reading and writing, specific vocabulary skills and the appreciation of the language as found in literature.

ENGLISH II (SUM 002)

Course will review the mechanics of grammar and pursue a traditional approach to literature and composition skills.

ENGLISH III (SUM 003)

Course will stress literature and composition. A review of the mechanics of writing, grammar, and punctuation will be continued.

ENGLISH IV (SUM 004)

Course will stress a higher level of proficiency in the areas of reading, composition, and grammar. Included will be Greek, Roman and English Literature.

U.S. HISTORY I (SUM 005)

Course deals with the colonization of America through the Civil War and Reconstruction.

U.S. HISTORY II (SUM 006)

Course deals with the history of the United States from the year 1900 to the end of World War II. Also included: the study of local, state and federal government.

WORLD HISTORY/CULTURE (SUM 007)

Course is designed to familiarize student with the cultures associated with various geographic regions of the world.

BIOLOGY (SUM 008)

Course will focus on the basic principles of life and the organization of organisms as well as understanding the importance of these organisms in the environment.

CHEMISTRY (SUM 009)

Course will focus on the college prep. level of chemistry information.

PHYSICAL SCIENCE (SUM 010)

Course involves a study of selected major topics within the physical universe.

ALGEBRA I (SUM 011)

Course designed to introduce students to the basic concepts and topics of a high school Algebra I course.

BASIC MATH/CONSUMER MATH (SUM 012)

This course includes a review of basic math skills. Emphasis placed on applications, budgets, banking and skills needed for everyday living.

SPANISH I (SUM 013)

This course includes beginning level of foreign language. Skills such as listening, speaking, reading and writing.

HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION (SUM 014)

MIDDLE SCHOOL

HISTORY - MIDDLE SCHOOL (SUM 015)

Course is designed to allow seventh and eighth grade students to advance their skills in basic History.

MATH - MIDDLE SCHOOL (SUM 016)

Course is designed to allow seventh and eighth grade students to advance their skills in basic Math grammar.

ENGLISH - MIDDLE SCHOOL (SUM 017)

Course is designed to allow seventh and eighth grade students to advance their skills in basic English grammar and basic Reading skills.

SCIENCE - MIDDLE SCHOOL (SUM 018)

Course is designed to allow seventh and eighth grade students to advance their skills in basic Science grammar and basic Reading skills.

TUITION

\$250 PER COURSE.

ATTENDANCE

Student's application for admission to the Summer Academy program is a commitment to attend every scheduled class. Upon accumulation of 30 minutes or more of missed class time student will be required to make up the number of minutes. **VACATION TIME AND ANY ABSENCES FROM CLASS ARE NOT CONSIDERED EXCUSABLE REASONS FOR MISSING CLASS. IF THIS WERE TO OCCUR, MAKEUP FEE WILL BE CHARGED (\$75 per day per course).** This will be available the two days at the completion of the summer program.

TARDINESS

On the second tardy the student will be sent to the Summer Academy Administrator. Loss of credit may result.

TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks will be made available to students. Texts must be returned at the end of the Summer School session in the same condition they were received. *Students are financially responsible for damaged or lost books.* Grades or credit will not be granted to those who have obligations in this regard.

STUDENT GRADES

A final grade report for the session will be mailed by August 15, to the home of the student and to the office of the principal of the student's high

school.

CREDITS

If the student receives approval from their district school, they will receive full high school credit for all satisfactorily completed makeup courses.

ATTENDANCE

Vacation time and any absences from class are not considered excusable reasons for missing class. If this were to occur, make up fee will be charged. \$75.00 a day PER COURSE.

FACULTY

All members of the Summer Academy faculty are fully certified to teach assigned courses.

APPROVAL

The Summer Academy is fully accredited by the New Jersey State Department of Education.

TRANSPORTATION

Students are responsible for their own transportation. Parking is permitted on the left side of the high school building.

CONTRACT

A contract outlining all expectations will be given to each student on the first day of class. It must be returned and signed by both legal guardian and student.
