

“BEST OF THE SIXTIES” CD PROJECT

As a review of the many types of music that came out of the 1960’s, you are going to create a “Best of the 60’s” album. No, you do not have to actually *make* the CD (unless you are feeling really ambitious); you will simply be choosing which songs to put on the album and making the CD cover/booklet.

You can use any of YOUR favorite songs (by artists we have covered in class), with the following specifications:

1. **You MUST include at least ONE song from every genre of music we’ve talked about in class** (listed on the “Sixties Overview” handout): rock, soul, folk rock, psychedelic rock, Motown, British pop/rock, and (unfortunately) teen idols.
2. **You cannot include more than TWO songs from one particular artist.** For that matter, you should have no more than two artist “repeats” (so only two artists can appear twice and no more than twice!)

TO HAND IN, you will create a CD booklet which **MUST** include:

- Some sort of **ARTWORK/PICTURE** on the front cover
- A **BLURB** about the album in general (example below)
- A **LIST** of songs, including the **ARTIST** and the **YEAR** it was released!
- **LYRICS** for every song
- **SOURCES** listed on the back (websites, etc.)

(You may also include pictures of the bands, artist info, or anything else you think is relevant. The more “extras” you include, the more points you will get for creativity!)

Example of a CD “blurb”:

The 1960’s was an era of great change, politically, socially and musically. “The Best of the Sixties” encompasses all of the musical genres of this exciting time, from the teen idols to the folkies to the rockers. Enjoy the sounds of the sixties again and again with this great song collection.
