- RETURN:** 6:30 A.M. approximately June 17th
(Note: You must arrange for a ride for your child's pickup)
- DRESS:** Comfortable. No bags and no purses allowed

The students will arrive at approximately 1:00 a.m. where there will be games, fun, music and food. At 3:30 a.m. a continental style breakfast will be set up for them. Refer to daveandbusters.com for more information.

There will be approximately 20 chaperones and two EMTs that will be accompanying the students, as well as the facility providing their own security.
