Dear Parents and Guardians:

This year, all students who are currently enrolled in a Biology class for the first time will be taking the Biology End of Course Examination and the Biology Performance Test. For planning purposes, the regular Biology test will take place on May 18th and the Biology performance test will take place on May 19th. Both tests will take place in the morning beginning at 7:45 a.m. There will be no delayed opening during either of the Biology examinations. All other students will be following their normal schedules.

Students taking the Biology examinations will be testing in the New Gym, Boys' Gym and in some resource centers. Your child's test location is noted below.

As with all state testing, NJDOE directives prohibit backpacks, handbags, cell phones, any other electronic devices, food, and water bottles in the testing areas. Please remind your children to leave these items in their lockers during testing. Students should have nothing with them other than pencils. Ignoring these directives will result in removal from the testing situation. To prepare for this assessment, students should get a good night's rest prior to the test and eat a healthy breakfast each morning. Again, stress to your child the importance of this test. Poor performance can impact his or her graduation.

- Attendance will be taken in the testing site, so students must report directly to their designated locations.
- Just as is required for SAT testing, every student must present a North Hunterdon High School I.D. card or a driver's license each day of testing before they will be allowed to participate in Biology testing.
- All students participating in testing will return to class after they have completed their testing requirements for the day. They will go to lunch during their normal lunch periods. If a student will miss lunch, he or she should pick up a lunch pass from the Principal's secretary after testing.
