PSAT Results:

Sophomores and Juniors who took the PSAT will have the opportunity to receive their results, along with a short instructional presentation, on Tuesday, December 13th during their lunch periods. A PowerPoint presentation by the counselors will be provided to assist the students in reading and interpreting their results, as well as providing recommendations for putting that information to use. Students will receive a pass to come to the theater during their lunch period; those who are unable to take advantage of this opportunity will be able to meet with the counselor individually at their convenience.

Scheduling Information Meetings:

All current freshmen, sophomores and juniors will attend scheduling information meetings during their history classes on Tuesday, December 20th. They will be advised by counselors regarding course selection for the coming year, and will be provided with other information that will assist them in making their course selections, including access to the Course Selection Guide online. Current sophomores and juniors will also be provided with a presentation about Hunterdon County Polytech programs.
