The objective of the School Based Youth Services/Initiatives Program is to help assure that youth will obtain needed assistance in an accessible location. The goal of the program is to promote mental and physical health, and provide support for youth to successfully complete high school, become employable or pursue higher education.

The program provides a comprehensive set of services to youth on a one-stop shopping basis at a site in or near their secondary school. These services include employment counseling, preventative health care, substance abuse identification, individual and/or group and family counseling, and recreation.

As a result of services being provided on-site at the schools, it is necessary that certain school policies be adhered to in the interest of the safety of all students. Students receiving school based services will be sent passes excusing them from classes.
