What is the PSAT test?

Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a program co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) is an objective test measuring verbal and mathematical abilities that have been shown to be related to success in college work. It helps the student prepare for the College Board's SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test). As a junior student, you will have the opportunity of entering the scholarship competition sponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Program.

Who should take PSAT? - Students who will be a *sophomore or juniors* in October 2010.

Why should students take PSAT?

- Provides valuable information with areas a student can develop to improve Test Scores for SAT (student profile).
- Offers information to start searching careers of interest to student.

How long is each section?

- *Critical Reading* includes two 25-minute sections
- *Mathematics* contains two 25-minute sections
- *Writing skills* contains a 30-minute multiple-choice questions
