Mr. Lockhart thanked the Association, and especially senior parents, for all the support this year.

Mr. Angeline also thanked the Association for the support this year. He specifically thanked the Association for hosting the recent spring concert receptions and the music department banquet.

Mr. Angeline said that 141 students have registered for the 09-10 marching band. Marching band camp letters will be sent electronically this year, rather than through the postal service. Emails will be sent towards the end of July. The fall marching band schedule has already been posted on the music department website.

Four students will attend the drum major summer camp. As in the past, the Association will pay the upfront costs (4 X \$275) and then request reimbursement for the difference between the cost and the Association subsidy.

Mr. Angeline said that he intends to purchase music at J.W. Pepper with the \$500 grant provided by PSE&G. The Association asked that the money be spent before the end of the month (June 2009) for accounting purposes.

### Treasurer Report

Mr. Maggio distributed the treasurer's report. It appears that the Association will realize a slight profit for the year. It was noted that several income lines need to be adjusted to better reflect the source.

Members were reminded to submit any outstanding items as the fiscal year ends June 30.

The proposed budget for 2009-2010 is not yet available. It will be presented at the July meeting.

### Committee Activities

Fundraising: Proposed 09-10 fundraising paperwork due to NHHS Administration by July 1.

The Association will have the 50/50 raffle for the Westfield home football game on Oct. 9 and the Scotch Plains-Fanwood home football game on Nov. 6.

Other 09-10 fundraisers will include Entertainment Book sales, two Wal-Mart bake sales, homecoming coat check on Oct. 16/17 and the spring 50/50 raffle.
