Student Responsibility: **Students must collect registration form from Mrs. Golday in Principals Office.**

Students may register for no more than two courses per semester. They may take no more than 16 credits in an academic year, but no more than 22 credits during their high school career. Due to Seton Hall policy freshman students are not eligible for this program.

Students must obtain specific Seton Hall course numbers and course names from the appropriate AP instructor listed above.

Students must return completed registration form and check made out to Seton Hall University to Mrs. Golday in the Principals Office. Fall 2008 tuition is \$60.00/credit regular Seton Hall tuition is > \$797 per credit.
