We are fast approaching another school year. The staff and administration at North Hunterdon High School are looking forward to meeting you this fall. Join with us in a “commitment to excellence” that will make the 2010 - 2011 school year a productive one for you and everyone in our school community.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION:

NHHS provides a Freshman Orientation program on the first day you are in the building. This experience will take place from **9:45 a.m. to 3:10 p.m. on Wednesday, August 25th**. Bus cards with times and bus stop locations will be mailed in August. Bus pick-up for Freshman Orientation will be exactly **two hours** later than the scheduled pick-up time, following the normal “two hour delay” schedule. Students should be at the bus stop at least five minutes prior to pick-up. Dismissal is scheduled for **3:10 p.m.**

ACTIVITIES AND ATHLETICS FAIR:

An Activities and Athletics Fair is included in the Freshman Orientation program from 2:30-3:10 p.m. The fair will take place in the New Gym and will allow freshmen to explore many co-curricular options.

OPTIONAL FRESHMEN PARENT/STUDENT PROGRAM:

After the Activities and Athletics Fair, an optional program for ninth graders and their parents will be hosted by the North Hunterdon Guidance department at 3:15 p.m. in the Theatre. All students in attendance at this program must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

BEGINNING HIGH SCHOOL:

Please note the following information regarding the opening of school:

- Freshmen are scheduled to report to the high school Theatre by 9:45 a.m. on Wednesday, August 25, for Freshman Orientation.
- The buses will pick up students **two hours** later than the normal time printed on the bus card students will receive.
- Buses will leave the high school at **3:10 p.m.** to return students to their homes.
- When students arrive at the high school on August 26th, they should go promptly to their Alpha homerooms (directions posted in the hallways), where they will be instructed on the day’s activities.
- Information regarding bus route description and approximate time of daily pick-up will arrive in a separate mailing. Students need to be at their bus stops at least five minutes before the time printed on transportation card.

As you approach this new school experience, I would like to remind you that your education is more than a mark on a report card. School is also about people and opportunities. Your education expands with all the experiences you encounter in your school career. I would like to draw your attention to the fine array of clubs, athletic teams, and co-curricular activities that are available to you.
