Updated December College Information - Remember, you must submit your transcript release forms at least **10 school days** prior to the deadline. Keep in mind the holiday break is only *three weeks* away. **Students with a December 30/January 1 deadline should submit their Transcript Release Forms by December 12th.** If you have an issue working within this timeline, then please contact your counselor ASAP! **Remember**, your applications do not need to be complete in order to submit a transcript release form.
