We wanted to follow up with you on the details for medication/supplies pick up. The dates have been set for student locker clean out, textbook and senior Chromebook returns. On June 2-June 5, students have been designated specific days and times where they are to come to school for these tasks. During their allotted time slot, medications or other medical supplies can also be picked up for that student.

Please keep in mind that only inhalers and epipens can be picked up by the student. Any other medication must be picked up by an adult during the student's allotted time in order to provide safe social distancing practices for all students and staff. If you do not wish to pick up any remaining medications for your students, we are able to discard them for you. We will have to discard any remaining medications if not retrieved by the last day of school, June 5<sup>th</sup>.
