### **Collaboration Permitted**

#### **Written Assignments & Projects**

For this assignment, you are encouraged to:

- consult with peers
- share resources
- discuss materials
- proofread/edit for others

However, you should ensure that any written work you submit for evaluation is the result of your own research and writing. You should also properly cite all resources including books, articles, websites, etc. that have helped you with your work. If you received any help with your writing (feedback on drafts, etc), you must also acknowledge this assistance.

#### **Homework:**

For this assignment you are permitted to:

- research answers using your class text and teacher provided materials, but not the Internet
- consult reliable Internet resources in order to produce properly paraphrased responses with appropriate citations
- consult with parents or teachers
- discuss the readings and notes with peers but not answers to specific questions

### **Problem Sets (Math & Science)**

For this assignment, you are encouraged to consult with your classmates as you work on problem sets.

However, after discussions with peers, make sure that you can work through the problem yourself and ensure that any answers you submit for evaluation are the result of your own efforts. You should also properly cite all resources including books, articles, websites, etc. that have helped you with your work. If you received any help with your problem sets, you must also acknowledge this assistance.

### **Collaboration Not Permitted**

To preserve the integrity and intent of this assignment, students should be aware that collaboration of any sort on any work submitted is not allowed.
