Spring Trip – Williamsburg, Virginia

April 20 – 23, 2023

Trip Cost: \$859 per student, quad occupancy

Cost Includes:

- 3 nights' accommodations at the Embassy Suites Williamsburg, Williamsburg, VA, or similar
- 6 meals, including tax and gratuities:
 - 2 Breakfasts
 - 1 Breakfast Cruise
 - 1 meal voucher in Busch Gardens
 - 2 Dinners
- Transportation via private, deluxe motorcoaches with VCR
- All sightseeing as indicated in the itinerary
- Music in the Parks performance package including festival adjudication, taped and written comments, trophy for each performing group, souvenir pin and Awards Ceremony
- Admissions include:

 - Ripley's Believe It or Not
 - Busch Gardens Williamsburg
 - 2-Hour "All-You-Can-Ride"
 - wristband at GoKarts, Plus!

- Professional Security Guard on duty at the hotel each evening
- Short Hills Tours Escort throughout the trip
- All taxes and gratuities, including end-of-trip gratuity to Escort and Drivers

Note from NHMA:

Tour comment from Short Hills Tours:

Tour cost quoted is based on a minimum of 150-159 student passengers. Should group size fall below minimum, a fair and reasonable surcharge will be applied.

Note from NHVRHSD:

If the minimum number of student passengers falls considerably below the estimated group size for this tour itinerary, the trip may be canceled by NHVRHSD. This is to ensure that the fair and reasonable surcharges listed above do not further burden our students' families. This is also to ensure that performing groups have the minimum number of participants to actually take part in festivals and adjudications.

COVID Protocols & Procedures:

Participation requires that all students and chaperones adhere to all protocols and procedures implemented by suppliers at the time of this tour including, but not limited to; temperature checks, acceptable face coverings and social distancing. Any passenger unable or unwilling to comply with these protocols may be refused access, or be requested to leave, by the supplier. It will be the responsibility of the school to ensure that all procedures and protocols are followed, at all times.

Update 10/5/2022: The trip cost has been communicated to the School District and to all stakeholders at a rate of Quad Occupancy for student rooms. Any students interested in lesser occupancy for hotel rooms should anticipate a surcharge on top of the trip cost quoted in all paperwork.
