Performance Course Grading Policy

Marking Period Grades

75% of the marking period grade will be determined by class participation grades and any quizzes, tests and/or projects within the marking period.

25% of the marking period grade will be determined by your participation in musical performances

- multiple performances within a marking period will combine to equal 25%, of your total grade
- performance at graduation may be required in some courses. Unexcused absence will result in a reduced final examination grade.
- In the event that there are no performances during a marking period, class participation and assessment averages will comprise 100% of the marking period grade.

Class Participation

At the end of each marking period, the student will receive a class participation grade. Considered factors include punctuality, attentiveness, effort, conduct, leadership, attitude, etc.

<u>Assessments</u>

Written tests, quizzes, projects, performance tests and/or alternate assessments may be given to help determine the students' marking period grades.

Attendance and participation at concerts

All students in performing arts classes are required to perform in all concerts. In the event of an illness or a death in the family or an administrative approved absence, the director should be notified, and the student will not be penalized. Unexcused absences will result in a 0% being given for the performance participation grade.
