## Faculty Report - Ms. Meo

- Thanks to music parents for sharing your students! New schedule this year is working well and both teachers and students are adjusting. Ensembles are up and running; Choir has started slowly with daily rehearsals. Info on CJ MEA Region Ensembles: open to any choral ensemble. Auditions are in December and students perform in J anuary.
- Fall play auditions are underway, and the spring musical choice is "Thoroughly Modern Millie," which is a tap show. Kerrie Decker will be running extra tap sessions in preparation for the auditions.
- The regional Broadway show of "Wicked" in Philadelphia is closing soon and stars one of our former graduates, Jessica Vosk (2002). She will be finishing the show and wants to come to NHHS to do a fall master class, hopefully in October.


## Faculty Report - Mr. Angeline

- Echo of Ms. Meo's feelings about the new schedule. Everyone seems to like it and it is working well. It is different but will soon be old hat for everyone. Longer classes are the biggest challenge, but ultimately it is a good thing.
- Ensembles up and running, J azz is still getting ready.
- Marching Band
$\checkmark$ Appreciate parents helping with summer rehearsals, refreshments, pizza party. Performance went well. Our annual marching competition will be before the second home game at 5 p.m.
$\checkmark$ Uniform distribution went well. Everyone was fit and much appreciation to the crew that helped Nancy with sewing.
$\checkmark$ First game away at Summit this Saturday; 1:30 pregame show, 11:30 arrival, 12:00 bus departs. Summit will provide snacks for our students along with our own.
$\checkmark$ Upcoming Events: Sunday is the special Triathlon event at Spruce Run, Freshman Tea, football games, Phillipsburg Festival, Columbus Day parade in NYC.
$\checkmark$ First home game next Friday on Singley Field. The loading dock area repairs will not be done by then. Loading will be done at Math/Science wing by Nisim and his crew until dock area is complete.
$\checkmark$ New uniforms
District is committed to it. Committee of Six: Mr. Angeline, Mr. Hopta, Nancy G, two students, and one other parent will determine selection and it is hoped to go out for bid by the end of the month.
Connie questioned sizing of first purchased set and Mr. Angeline indicated uniforms will be sized for next year's band students with some extra "stock" uniforms. Very exciting! Nisim questioned if budget was approved. Mr. Angeline noted this has been in budget for several years. Wynn questioned if Tirpok was going to contribute because of the fire. Mr. Angeline noted that all paperwork has been submitted for claim and that the insurance company should handle from here on out. Money was there before the fire; fire just moved the timetable up.
- Questions
$\checkmark$ Nisim: What are the two band festivals? Phillipsburg and Bloomfield. Mr. Angeline will forward information regarding where warm ups will take place. Nice stadium was one selling point to go to Bloomfield.
$\checkmark$ Connie: Approached by PTSA Vice President looking to see if they can do a co-fundraiser with us. Discussed whether we should invite them to our next meeting to brainstorm ideas. Also, the Cheer group is having a blackout bucket hat fundraiser. Did the band want to participate with the hat part of the sale? Band could be wearing hat that we buy (cost is $\$ 9$ per hat). Mr. Angeline requested the Cheer group contact him to discuss further.
$\checkmark$ Nancy: Date for Applebee's fundraiser is December 16.
$\checkmark$ Suzanne: Can we send someone to talk to the band members about the fruit sale? Mr. Angeline approved this request.


## Corresponding Secretary Report - Suzanne Adams

- Connie: Received thank you note from Kristen Fodor to Audrey, thanking NHMA for the senior scholarship.
- Kathleen: Daughter says thank you again for the Gary Gilbert scholarship.
- Suzanne: A card for Mr. Andrews needs to be given to Mr. Angeline to forward on, as we didn't have his personal home address. Group discussion followed and voted to let it go and not send a card. Also, do we need to send card for Matthew DaSilva who died in J une and Bernadine Goepfert (ICC parish) who died in August? She has three surviving children but not sure if any were music students. ## Treasurer's Report - Jen Fasciano (see attached reports)

- 2017/18 budget basically the same as last year. Changes:
$\checkmark$ Marching Band increased from \$1,500 to \$2,000 to include ShopRite's $\$ 500$ gift card; we have not received this yet.
$\checkmark$ Prism concert expenses last year included $\$ 500$ in tech tips. We need to set a limit for tip amounts for the future. Nancy: in the past we did $\$ 25$ or $\$ 30$ per person. Connie will email Ms. Meo and let her know we will have an envelope for each person the night of the show. Someone will be the holder of tips. Group agreed.

Patricia had the original documents, so Nancy will call Patricia and find out what to do. Also, there is a current tax exempt form so we don't have to pay tax.
- Nancy: Have not made a deposit for membership yet; over \$600 in PayPal and $\$ 140$ in checks/cash.


## Membership Report - Nancy Gaidos

- There are 40 members as of now; 31 paid on PayPal and 10 of 40 are new. Four haven't paid yet. A year ago we had 56 members at this point.

## - Florida Fruit Association Fundraiser

Connie: Approval came through. We are confirming dates, getting blurbs out to Maren. Sue: Want to start the sale now, heard that last year it ended too soon, concern in wanting fruit to come in during the holiday concerts to make pickup easy, especially with storms. Targeting end of sale to be Monday, November 13. Then two weeks to compile all info and the goal is to get everything to FFA before Thanksgiving. Website will open in mid-September to place orders there. Need an updated blurb to Maren and newspaper, email to membership, flyer attached to order form with prices and instructions (helpful last year). Prices to be written direct on order form v . listed on separate paper. Need a student name to order. Cost of apples and pears increased; otherwise the same prices and products. Need to think about where to store it when it comes in. 150 bushels are needed to place the order; last year we surpassed that. If over 250 bushels, we get free shipping. Every student (85) needs to sell at least three items. Advertising pushed by Maren. Sue will be at tomorrow's Back to School night to distribute flyers. Nisim: Please check link to make sure last year's data is cleared out. Link has to be live.
Kathleen: Confirmed October 15 as date for Fall Newsletter.

- Stadium Seat Cushions

Connie: In hindsight, should have placed a larger order. Sold for $\$ 8$ or $\$ 15$ for two at graduation. Several comments that they were too expensive, but will stick with pricing. Concern is that we will have to order again by the end of the season. Should we run a batch at our own cost since it took so long to get sponsors? Nisim: Release a letter to let sponsors know fair warning their name was only on original 150 purchased. We will order more - do you want in? Linda: Do sponsors have music students? Do another count and let them know. Sue: Going forward, sponsors should get a whole school year; we shouldn't ask them to pay more than once per year. Then we would start again in the spring with a new year.

Connie: Haven't called them yet. Do we want to run a Christmas sale along with the fruit? Is it worth a try? Sue: Worth a try, lots of products. Not got approval yet, but sent through.
