Department News

Great concert season! Thank you for receptions and poinsettias. Bands will be performing for 8th graders during their orientation trip here to drum up interest in music classes. Soon, course selections for next year start. Upcoming events: NHTO show *Bye Bye Birdie*, Prism concert in March, Spring Cabaret, Williamsburg trip. This Friday is the Master Class with Ithaca A cappella group. We are getting some new equipment for theater and improvements made to the sound system.

• <u>Spring Trip to Williamsburg VA</u> 157 kids are signed up; three dropped out. Final payment due Feb. 24. Fundraising is all done with 58 students participating.

- ➤ When are Fundraiser payments due? Mr. Hopta will be sending out approximately 60 emails to participating students with their numbers and amount due. Alexa will then write one check to Short Hills Tours.
- ➤ How do we proceed with a new master class request involving the Newport Jazz Festival? A \$1,000 grant was given to NHMA to use for us to have an instrumentalist who plays clarinet, flute, and sax visit. We also still have \$300 remaining in the budget this year. Alexa will forward info to Mr. Hopta.

Corresponding Secretary Report – Susan Wallace

 From Jen F: Thank you notes were sent to ShopRite, Stop & Shop, and Basil Bandwagon for Banquet food. Jen P asked if a note was sent to Dominick's? Not sure if Susan did it, so Jen F will check.

Treasurer Report – Alexa Parliyan

- Indemnity insurance bill for \$126 is coming, which covers theft from those of us who handle any money. We already pay \$400 for liability insurance just for the building. This policy provides \$1 million coverage and is good for all events. We were paying too much, but now we are paying the right amount. Got one other quote which was higher. Should we take the indemnity insurance? Balances are normally below \$10,000. Group then discussed this issue with members reporting that theft does happen often in volunteer organizations. We could get the amount reduced to \$5k. Alexa will call. Group agreed that procedures must be in place. We have no audit done, so we are somewhat vulnerable. An Audit position could be a new chair going forward.
- Are we Exempt or Non-exempt? We are tax exempt.
- Continue with the Amazon Smile program; can get a lot of money!
- Should we have a mid-year budget review meeting?
 Everything is pretty much on target, so no. Will re-visit at end of February after trip payment is made.

 Next time this should be a flat 30% profit. We still need online sales numbers. Dawn will call. We will get a check from them.

For Winter Concerts I and II, we sold 55 plants for \$220. We might want to up the price of the plants for next year. We are getting the delivery for free. Extra wreaths and swags sold as well.

Winter Musical Sales

- Candygrams: last year people were asking about these, which cost \$1 to write a note to give to the performers along with candy. People need to know about these in advance! (Maren could help with this). People could also order flowers online and pay through PayPal; we could do the same thing for the candygrams. \$1 is the cheapest you can get the candy bars. Should we do this as a fundraiser and make it \$2 each? Group discussed this option and decided that we made a lot of money on the flowers alone, so don't really need another fundraiser. Kids should get the email blasts from Maren as well. Need to print up more candygram slips and buy more candy.
- ➤ Flowers: last year we ran out. A dozen roses sold for \$10. Should we sell for \$15 instead? A dozen mini carnations sold for \$5. Group decided to up the price to \$15 on a dozen roses and \$8 on a dozen mini carnations. Single carnations will sell for \$1. Presales will be available on roses and carnations, and single carnations will also be available at the show. We were late to advertise as well, so if we get the info out earlier, we may get more sales.
- Concessions: we sell soda and water, popcorn is donated.
