Hello All,

I want to take this time to once again welcome all of our new students and their families to the Music Department at North Hunterdon High School. I also want to say welcome back to all of our returning students and their families. The North Hunterdon community has a musical tradition of excellence that spans generations, and it is in no small part because of the support we get from all of you. We are fortunate that we have so many multi-year members within our ensembles; this continued participation is critical so that all of our students, new and veteran musicians alike, can thrive and come together to make great music for each other and our greater community.



One of our new initiatives this year is directly related to the strength of our performing ensembles. Our largest ensembles, which are string orchestra, concert band, and concert choir, now provide an opportunity for multi-year members to receive honors weight for their participation in those groups. We wanted the chance to both challenge and reward our veteran performers, on whose presence we depend and who we always expect to lead through good playing. Enrollment requires two prior years within the ensemble and a successful audition/interview. We are currently working with our first students within these new course offerings, and are excited to continue to build our program.

You probably have already received information from me regarding our Department Trip, which is April 20th- 23rd and is open to students involved in any ensemble offered at North. Please know that my colleague Kathleen Cudworth (kmeo@nhvweb.net) and I (chopta@nhvweb.net), as lead chaperones, are happy to answer any questions you may have about this trip. Of course, the NHMA will be assisting us with this and many other endeavors throughout the year, and they will be providing more information on fundraising towards the cost of this trip. Hello, Music Department Families!

It is my great honor to work with your children every day. In this ever-changing world, it is wonderful to know that the support of the NHMA is still something we as Faculty can rely on. Thank you most of all for encouraging your children in their musical growth, and by becoming involved yourselves, giving them the example they need to remain active members of the Department year after year. Like I said at the New Student Welcome in September, our ensembles are not designed to be "once and done" experiences. They are meant to be enjoyed for all four years!

A few things I would like to bring to mind: We are shifting to a more unified look with our concert attire, starting this year. You should have been emailed an order/measurement form and instructions on how to measure your child for their particular clothing item(s). Order form and payment are due to me (or any Music teacher) by Friday, October 7th. We need to leave ample time for returns/exchanges and for shipping delays, as I'm sure we are all experiencing right now! These outfits will be worn at least three times by ALL ensemble members this year, many more if your child sticks with the program for future years (and even more if they are coming on the Department trip - more on that soon!). If your child is a senior, they may already own said items, as choir members used them for performance wear during the first half of 2019-20.

Secondly, our Department is travelling again! We are finally taking the trip that was planned for April 2020, three years later! Dates of the trip are set for April 20-23 (NOT spring break), in Williamsburg, VA, and all performing ensemble members are invited (including Marching Band)! More details will be given shortly, like fundraising opportunities by the NHMA, but suffice it to say that the teachers are so excited to expose the students to more performing and more bonding experiences as a full Department. There is something about taking the skills we have learned here and bringing them to a new and different environment that keeps us growing as musicians and growing closer together as people.

As always, we thank you for your incredible support over the years. Here is to an even better school year than last!







Future Lions Concert Band

This coming November/December, we are excited to host our second annual Future Lions Concert Band, Fall Edition. The Future Lions Concert Band is an opportunity for middle school band students to rehearse and perform with a North Hunterdon High School band director, the North Hunterdon Wind Ensemble, and other select North Hunterdon Band students. The Fall Edition of the NHHS Future Lions Concert Band works on 1-2 pieces of band literature, and consists of 4 short evening rehearsals at North Hunterdon High School. The experience culminates with the group performing on stage at the NHHS Winter Concert #2. This offering provides prospective middle school band students with an opportunity to get a taste of the band program at NHHS, work with the NHHS Wind Ensemble, and a chance to work with your future band director. Any current 7th or 8th grade band member at one of our feeding middle schools is eligible to participate. Information for any NHHS Band student wishing to volunteer will be coming out shortly!

Last Spring, we had a very successful charter of Tri-M Music Honors Society. This is a program of the National Association for Music Education (NAFME), which focuses on creating future leaders in music education and music advocacy. This does not mean it is focused on those who intend to make a career in music, but rather have a dedication to the craft and contribute to the community using music as a vessel.


Tri-M is the only music honor society for middle and high school students in the country. The organization recognizes students that have gone above and beyond both academically and musically as well as providing students with leadership opportunities to make a difference in their community through music -based service projects. There are more than 2,100 chapters across 50 states and 15 countries! Each year, student members contribute more than 750,000 service hours to their school and local communities and raise nearly \$1 million for causes they care about. It is a very worthy organization to dedicate time and energy to.

We will be holding a fall membership drive for sophomores through seniors in the weeks to come. Requirements for membership are: students must be enrolled in at least one music class for at least one semester, have a 2.0 GPA in their core classes, and a 3.0 in their music class(es), and be of strong character. (Freshman will be eligible for membership in the Spring membership drive.) We hope you and your student will consider Tri-M Music Honors Society! We are still very much in the first steps of our chapter and are looking forward to including new friends in creating our path forward!




