 - Visitors must depart by midnight
 - No alcohol, illegal drugs, smoking, or in appropriate behavior
 - No pets
 - No tents or campers
 - All participants must stay inside the designated area at all times
- Anyone caught breaking these rules will need to leave the event immediately*
