Service-in-a-Box

A Service-in-a-Box project brings the Cradles to Crayons warehouse to you. First, students, teachers, and parents collect the children's items Cradles to Crayons needs. Then, the school community processes the donations at their school the same way we would in our warehouse. The donations are inspected, sorted, and packed at the drive location so they are good-to-go upon delivery to our warehouse.

Service-in-a-Box allows us to be more efficient in quickly getting essential items into the hand of kids who need them and is a wonderful opportunity for adults and children of all ages to provide meaningful, tangible service as a school community.
