WHAT IS PROJECT CONNECTIONS?

Project Connections is a comprehensive academic and counseling support service for students with specific learning disabilities who are enrolled in mainstream programs at Middlesex County College. Project Connections is supported by a grant from the U.S. Department of Education Student Support Services Program.

WHAT SERVICES DOES PROJECT CONNECTIONS PROVIDE?

1. Two day Summer Program and needs assessment
2. Support course sequence, including
 - study skills
 - self-awareness and advocacy
 - computer literacy
 - educational and career planning
3. Course accommodations
4. Individual and group tutoring by educational specialists
5. Adapted testing
6. Writing Lab
7. Counseling (group and individual)
8. Academic advising
9. Priority registration
10. Transition services

WHO ARE PROJECT CONNECTIONS STUDENTS?

Project Connections students are students with average to above average intelligence who have a documented specific learning disability and who plan to graduate from MCC and transfer to a baccalaureate degree institution.

WHO ARE PROJECT CONNECTIONS STAFF?

Project Connections staff include educational specialists and counselors who work as a team to provide educational and emotional support for students with specific learning disabilities.

WHY SHOULD STUDENTS USE OUR SERVICES?

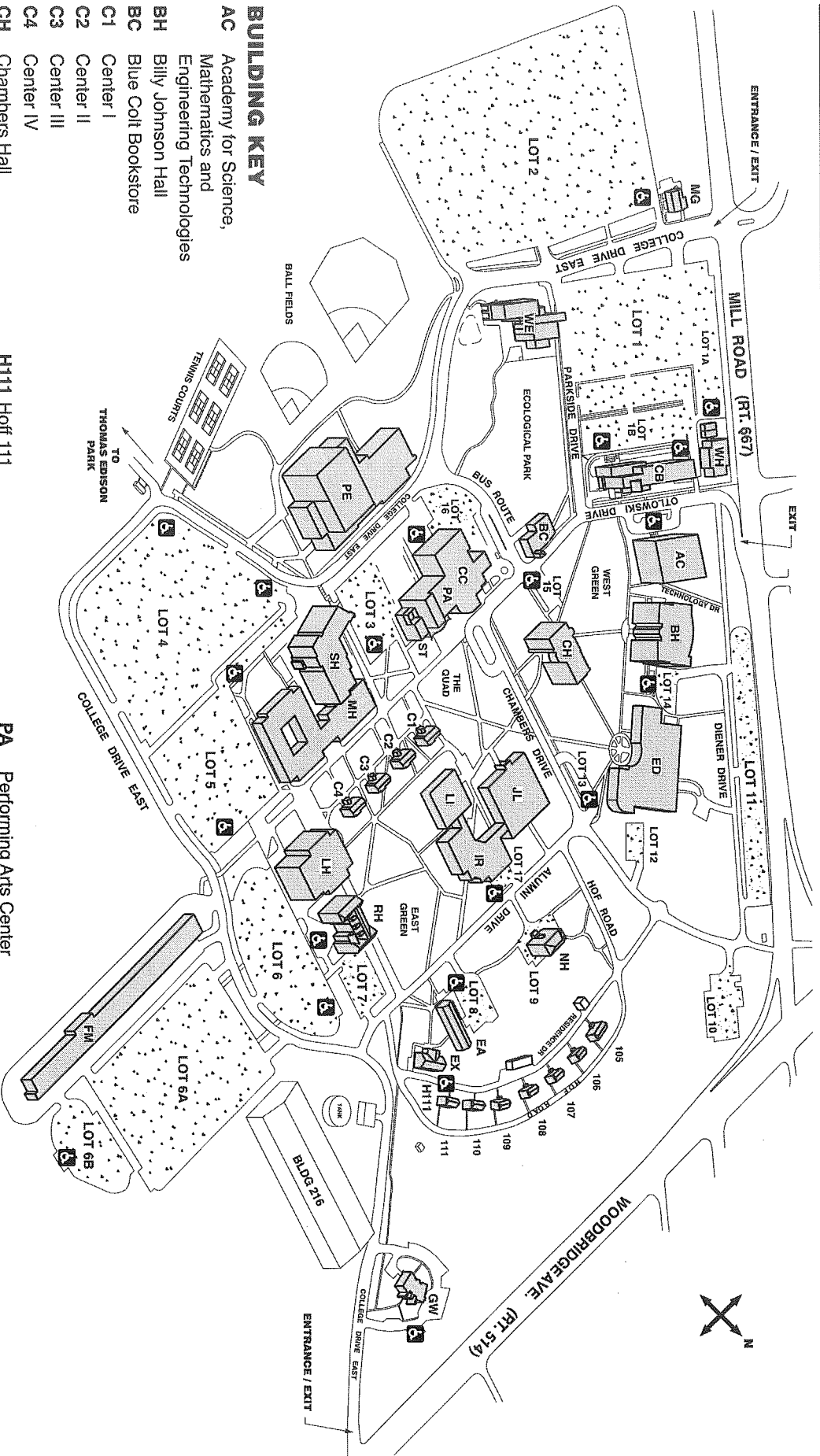
With appropriate academic and counseling support, many students with specific learning disabilities can meet with success at college and become more independent.
