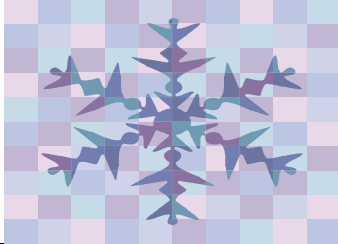

Simon Youth Foundation Community Scholarship Program – Grade 12. Due 1/31/10. Financial need, unusual personal or family circumstances, academics, etc. Awards (197) of \$1,400. The program will take into consideration the future potential of each applicant, recognizing those who have made significant personal improvements or contributions to their communities. AEMP Foundation Scholarship Due 5/1/10. If you are pursuing a degree in diesel technology there is a \$500 scholarship per semester available. See Ms. Fresoli in guidance for application.

New Jersey Elks Special Needs Scholarship Due 4/2/10. For senior with physical disability who will be furthering their education. 4 scholarships worth up to \$2500 per year. See Ms. Fresoli for application.

2010 Scholar Athlete Milk Mustache of the Year (SAMMY) – Grade 12. Due 03/05/10. Academics, 35%; athletic excellence, 35%; Leadership, 15%, Citizenship/Community service, 15%. A 250-word essay about “How Milk Has Helped In My Academics and/or Athletics” is required

NJ Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation Scholarship – Grade 12. Due 04/16/10. NJ Memorial in Holmdel. Two \$2,500 Scholarships requires an essay (250-300 words) written on reflection of a visit to memorial in Holmdel, NJ. Visit <http://www.njvvmf.org/Scholarship> for information on the organization. Must be a NJ resident and follow the application instructions

These scholarships are college specific, you must be applying to that college to be eligible

Savannah College of Art and Design Scholarship – Grade 12. Due 02/01/10. \$18,000/year. Valid for programs in Savannah, Atlanta, Hong Kong, or online through eLearning.
