As summer approaches, United Way of Hunterdon County (UWHC) is busy preparing our annual Tools 4 School program, which provides students in need with school supplies necessary for a successful school year. This program is open to children in Hunterdon County schools who are eligible for Free/Reduced Lunch and/or families with a demonstrated need.

## How to receive a School Supply Kit(s):

- Each family that has school-age children in need must fill out a Tools 4 School Client Request Form. This
  form has been included, but can also be found on our website www.uwhunterdon.org. The only person
  outside of UWHC who will be aware of your request is the school nurse of the child's school. This notification
  helps us avoid duplication of services.
- You must send the form in by July 11 to be a top priority to receive an age-appropriate school kit. Forms can be sent back to UWHC by mail, email, or dropped off.
- Kit distribution to students will take place during the week of August 18 at a variety of locations. You will be notified by postcard on or around August 15<sup>th</sup> of the specific time and place to pick up the school supply kit(s).

**Kits include:** (Kits in age-appropriate backpacks as available, will be distributed; otherwise kits will be put into a regular bag for distribution)

- \*Elementary School Kit includes: Pencils, Crayons, Markers, Dry Erase Markers, Composition Book, Scissor, Wide-lined filler paper, Binder, Folders, Glue Stick, Pencil Case, and Pencil Sharpener
- \*Middle School Kit includes: Pens, Pencils, Colored Pencils, highlighter, College-lined paper/notebooks, Folders, Dividers, Pencil Case, pencil sharpener, Composition Book, Binder, Scientific Calculator
- \*High School Kit includes: Pens, Pencils, Highlighter, College-lined paper/notebooks, Folders, Binder, Dividers, pencil sharpener, and Post-it Notes.
- \*All school supplies are donated, so items in the kits may vary from the list stated above.

Families that fill out the enclosed Tools 4 School Client Request form and send it in by <u>July 11<sup>th</sup></u> will be a <u>top priority</u> for receiving an age appropriate school supply kit.
