Dear Members and Parents of the Class of 2012:

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate members of the Class of 2012 on their accomplishments to date, including for many, their acceptance into programs following graduation in June.

Unfortunately, a number of seniors have placed their graduation in jeopardy due to loss of credit for attendance reasons. **Students who have lost credit in their fall single semester courses have been notified by the Guidance Office in a previous correspondence. Students in full year courses and second semester courses have been notified of their current attendance status.** In an effort to ensure that all seniors have the opportunity to graduate with their classmates, the District will be offering a special "Senior's Only" credit restoration program. This program will allow seniors to regain credit for courses taken this year; prior year courses are not eligible. Seniors will have the opportunity to regain credit for two single semester courses or one full year course. For semester courses, students must attend a total of twelve hours of the credit restoration program, and for a full year course students must attend all twenty four hours of the program. An approved research project must also be completed. Topics for this project are subject specific and will be discussed on an individual basis. Successful completion of the Credit Restoration Program is dependent upon meeting both the time and project requirements and will result in credit being restored. Students will maintain the grade they received in the original course; no grade improvement is possible. Students who have failed the course are not eligible for credit restoration in that course.

The tentative schedule for the Credit Restoration Program is as follows: Mondays and Wednesdays 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM in the North Hunterdon Media Center. This program will begin on Monday, April 2 and end on Wednesday, May 30.

**Students must sign up for this program through their guidance counselor after a review of their graduation status.**
