

- 1. Draw a C major scale (c-d-e-f-g-a-b-c) in the piano roll view above.
- 2. Fill in a 'perfect 5^{th} ' above each note in the C major scale (ex. C G)
- 3. Fill in the middle white key for each of the chords in the C major scale (ex. C E G)
- 4. Determine how many half steps are between each of the notes of each chords
- 5. Play each of the chords using a basic piano patch
