Voorhees High School Presents: Catch Me If You Can

Voorhees High School Drama Club will be presenting the musical *Catch Me If You Can* on April 2, 3 and 4 at 7pm and April 5th at 2pm. *Catch Me If You Can* the musical is based on the true story of Frank William Abagnale Jr., who ran away from home at 16 when his parents' marriage disintegrated. He supported himself by writing bad checks. When his supply of checks ran out he started printing his own payroll checks. In an effort to meet girls and escape capture, he posed as a doctor, a Pan Am pilot, and a Louisiana prosecutor under assumed names. His misadventures in check fraud and false identity took him all over the world. Frank was pursued by numerous FBI agents, including those who the character Agent Carl Hanratty is based upon. Frank was eventually captured for his crimes.

The charismatic lead role of Frank Jr. will be played by Harry Sperduto, a Voorhees junior who many will remember from past roles including Ren McCormack in *Footloose*, Will Bloom in *Big Fish*, and Jimmy Ray Dobbs in *Bright Star*. When asked about what this opportunity meant to him, Sperduto said "Frank Jr. is a dream role for me and being able to play it right now (means) everything. This role has significantly impacted me in becoming a better person and a better actor, singer, and dancer. You have to have a drive, and that drive allowed me to achieve my goals in this show and allows me to surpass new ones every day".

The serious and slightly obsessive FBI agent in charge of bringing Frank Jr to justice, Carl Hanratty, is played by junior Mark Squindo. Mark's most recent role on the Voorhees stage was as Mayor Dobbs in *Bright Star*. Junior Ian Love will star as Frank Abagnale Sr., the master con artist, and Frank Jr.'s idol. Frank Jr.'s alluring French mother is played by junior dance captain Isabel Hepburn. Hanratty's top notch team of agents include Agent Johnny Dollar played by freshman Roman Melendez, Agent Todd Branton played by junior Stefan Stojanoski, who most recently was seen as Billy Cane in *Bright Star* and Agent Cod played by sophomore Tyler Zappa.

Ian Love whose past roles include Daddy Cane in *Bright Star*, and a comic turn as Zacky Price in *Big Fish* is excited for the opportunity to play Frank Senior. When asked about the challenges about this show, Love said "this role has challenged me in ways I've never been challenged before, but it has been a very worthwhile and rewarding experience to develop this character that is almost a complete foil to how I'd usually act". Junior Mark Squindo expressed a similar idea saying, "this show had me open up as an actor in ways that I didn't think I had been pushed (to do) before. (Being) Hanratty (has been) an amazing experience."

After months of running from the police Frank settles down and takes a job in an Atlanta hospital where he meets and falls for nurse Brenda Strong. Brenda is played by senior Nicole Rosales. Audience members will recognize Nicole as Wendy Jo from *Footloose*, Margot from *Legally Blonde*, the Witch from *Big Fish* and Mama Murphy from *Bright Star*. Nicole expressed her excitement about the upcoming show saying "*Catch Me If You Can* has greatly challenged me in aspects of dance, acting, and voice. Playing Brenda has been such a delight, she has given me strength through vulnerability. I can't wait for everyone to meet her." Sophomore and dance

captain Alastair Stewart plays Brenda's intimidating attorney father Roger Strong and senior Alexis Judd plays the energetic Carol Strong.

With new choreography by North Hunterdon dance team advisor and math teacher Megan Decker this ensemble is sure to entertain. Additional choreography has been provided by our creative and diverse team of dance captains including captain/choreographer junior Owen Tabor, and captains junior Grace Trumpy, junior Isabel Hepburn, junior Francesca Morella and sophomore Alastair Stewart.
