- (A.P.) Class Officers: Freshman now has exec board made up of 6 representatives and started tee-shirt fundraiser through Sneakers plus. Sophomores and Seniors are also sponsoring a tee-shirt fundraiser, while Juniors are promoting hats.
- (A.P.) Admin will continue to listen to the kids and give them the opportunity to present creative ideas.
- (A.P.) State restrictions continue to limit activities. A “wait and see” approach will continue with respect to any of our traditional events, including Jr. and Sr. Prom, Sr. Banquet, and Graduation. Cancellation of event should not come as a complete shock, should that happen. If Project Graduation can’t happen, perhaps we can do a Senior Field Day -- We will continue to work together to offer every possible event that we can.
- (A.B.) Due to the government restrictions, we (the PTSA) recognizes how difficult it is for the classes to fundraise. We would like to provide funds to each of the individual classes. The funds will be prorated based on the amount of time they could raise money for their senior year event goals.
- (A.P.) Senior parents should start seeing information on graduation and diplomas. Will try to move the senior banquet from April to May. PTSA will again do lawn signs – we had excellent feedback. The PTSA also traditionally offers Tshirts and we are talking to the seniors about those now. Hoping to offer them earlier to give the kids time to enjoy them prior to graduation.
