The purpose of the college guidance program at Episcopal is to help students understand that college selection is a process, a process which demands careful attention and participation, a process that is highly personal. Students should go through a period of self-reflection, the first step in the planning process. Consider many things: interests, talents, personal goals, strengths, and weaknesses. Be realistic when thinking about yourself. Do not be afraid to reach a dream, but keep one foot on the ground.

Each year, Episcopal students are encouraged to sign up to meet with many of the over one hundred college representatives that visit our campus. In the fall our students participate in the College Preview program, sponsored by St. Mark's, Hockaday, Greenhill, Parish, and Episcopal, welcoming approximately two hundred college representatives. Additionally, we believe in visiting college campuses in order to get a better idea of what the school is really like. There is no substitute for a college visit as a way of assessing the school for the best "fit."

We believe the more students become involved in the process, the more self-confident they will feel about their ability to make good decisions. The more time students invest in the process, the closer they will come to finding the college that suits them as individuals.
