

Voorhees math teacher, Barbara Wieteszka, administered the Fourth New Jersey Mathematics League Contest (NJLC) on January 13th. For the fourth time in a row, Voorhees ranked #1 in Hunterdon County. Although there were no perfect scores, four of our students received scores of 5/6: Daphne Roskowski, Hunter Keeth, Nicholas Simeon, and Sourish Das.

The NJLC has compiled a cumulative report for high scoring schools and students so far this year. Voorhees high school has a cumulative score of 99 and is ranked #12 in the state. Student, Zack Zamarra, is ranked in the top 100 students, with a cumulative score of 16 points.

Practical Arts Department News

Students in our Early Childhood Education program brought child development theory to life through a creative Valentine's Day project. After studying major theorists, students worked collaboratively to design preschool-themed Valentine boxes representing each theorist's beliefs about how children learn. They also wrote valentines from the perspective of their assigned theorist, comparing ideas about development, motivation, behavior, and learning. The project combined creativity with academic rigor and provided students with a meaningful, hands-on introduction to foundational figures who continue to influence early childhood classrooms today.

VHS Boys Track and Field Team won the Skyland Conference Small School Division Championship on 2/1. The boys scored a total of 132 points in a very impressive overall win.

Numerous athletes medaled in the meet overall:

Dillon Devine took first place in the 1600 and Tony Giello took 3rd place overall in the 1600. Avery Innis took 4th place in the 3200. 
