Opening of School

All students will report for a regular day of school on Thursday, August 27th which will be an A Day. Course schedules will be published in Aspen, our student information system, later this week. Cell Phone/Internet Enabled Devices Policy

In accordance with a recently enacted [law](#) and the New Jersey Department of Education's [2026 Guidance for Schools on Student Use of Internet-Enabled Devices](#), all school districts are required to adopt policies that prohibit the use of personal internet-enabled devices, from "Bell-to Bell". This policy requires that all personal internet-enabled devices must be turned off and not in use for the duration of the school day; from the first bell to the last bell. Except for circumstances outlined in the law and guidance, personal devices may not be used at any time during the school day, including during lunch or in between classes.

Electronic Communications Policy

Per Board Policies [4119.26/4219.26](#), staff members and students are prohibited from corresponding with each other through personal email addresses, cell phone numbers or social media sites. The only approved means of communication between staff members and students is through the district-issued email and Google accounts. Students should not give out their personal contact information to staff members. You can read more in the policies linked above.
