Dear Students and Parents of the Class of 2030,

Welcome to Voorhees High School! In a few short weeks, you will begin a very exciting and rewarding high school career. In the next four years, you will have many and varied opportunities for growth and success in academics, co-curricular activities, and student government. Freshman Orientation Program

We have scheduled an **orientation program for freshmen on Wednesday, August 26, 2026 beginning at 9:45AM in our auditorium.** On that day, a bus will pick you up at your bus stop exactly two hours later than the time indicated in the Transportation tab in ASPEN. We are a cashless cafeteria so an account must be created in PaySchools in order for you to make purchases in the cafeteria. Students enter their school ID number in the keypad at the register to make a purchase, which will be deducted from the PaySchools account. First Day of School

The first official day of school for all students is Thursday, August 27, 2026, which will be an A Day. We follow a rolling drop block schedule that includes A, B, C and D days. More information on how the schedule works will be sent when full course schedules are published in Aspen in the coming weeks. Student IDs

Students at Voorhees are required to carry their photo identification badges. Your freshman will be photographed during Freshman Orientation and provided with an ID as soon as they are processed.

PTSO

The [Parent Teacher Student Organization](#) plays a vital role at Voorhees. One of its most important functions is Project Graduation. Through a series of fundraisers throughout the year, the PTSO provides a substance-free night of celebration for our seniors following graduation. Parent/Student Handbook

We encourage you to become familiar with the information contained in this reference and mark the dates of important school events throughout the year. Of particular note, please read over the *attendance policy*, the *dress code*, and the *electronic devices policy*. These areas raise many questions every year for freshmen and their parents.

Cell Phone/Internet Enabled Devices Policy

In accordance with a recently enacted [law](#) and the New Jersey Department of Education's [2026 Guidance for Schools on Student Use of Internet-Enabled Devices](#), all school districts are required to adopt policies that prohibit the use of personal internet-enabled devices, from "Bell-to Bell". This policy requires that all personal internet-enabled devices must be turned off and not in use for the duration of the school day; from the first bell to the last bell. Except for circumstances outlined in the law and guidance, personal devices may not be used at any time during the school day, including during lunch or in between classes.

Access to the Student Information System (Aspen)

Freshmen parents/guardians should have received login information to access Aspen, our student information system. This system will allow you to view your student's schedule, assignments, attendance, locker information, and fees. In addition, your student's bus route and pick-up time is now available in Aspen. (Please note, the transportation department does not mail home bus cards.) If you already have an account in Aspen from last year, please note that your freshman will be automatically added to your account. Instructions on how freshmen can access their own login for Aspen has been emailed to parents and their login will be given to them during freshman orientation. If you have any problems with your parent Aspen account, please contact our database operations manager, Sherri DiMarcello, at sdimarcello@nhvweb.net.

Chromebooks and School Network Access

Our school district has a 1:1 initiative that provides a Chromebook and a school Google email account to every student. Chromebooks will be distributed to freshmen at orientation on Wednesday, August 26th. In order to receive a district-issued Chromebook, a parent must have completed the Technology Agreement Form in Aspen prior to orientation day. Form is located under Page Directory, then Technology Forms.

Students also have the option to bring their own device to school. For more information on accepted devices and things to consider, please visit our technology services website ([click here](#)). If your student would like to bring his/her own device, please select that choice in the Technology Agreement Form that must be completed in Aspen. The student's device will need to be registered on our school server, which can be done at orientation, or the student can bring his/her device to the Technology Resource Center on the second floor during the regular school day.

To access the school's network, parent/guardian and student must agree to the district's technology acceptable use policy in the Technology Agreement Form. If that section of the form is not completed by a parent/guardian, the student will be unable to log into the school's network or internet.

Media Center/Library

The mission of the Voorhees High School Library Media Center is to:

- encourage students and staff to find, evaluate, and ethically use information and ideas for their educational, informational, and recreational needs.
- promote an appreciation of literature that enables students to become lifelong readers and learners.

The North Hunterdon-Voorhees Regional School District Board of Education has a random substance testing policy. All students who participate in a co-curricular activity not required for graduation are subject to random substance testing. Any student planning to participate in a co-curricular activity must complete a consent form signed by his or her parent or guardian to be eligible for participation.
