Kim P welcomed everyone to the meeting. Suggested we might want to do a virtual meeting for our future meetings.

Graduation Signs – Sold 126 families purchased signs. PTSO ordered a couple of extra (all generic signs are sold) \$3215.00 collected - Our profit - \$ 1679.98 --- final payment amount due to Fast Signs - 1074.56

Kim was in contact with a representative of Fast Signs - signs might be done as early as Wednesday. Kim G will prepare the signs with bags and have a curbside pickup at VHS parking lot. Pick up might be 2 or 3 days depending on the amount of signs that need to be picked up.

Kim P suggested a board meeting call at another time to figure out the logistics.

Mr. Peterson suggested that the custodial staff could assist with passing out any signs that are not picked up on the scheduled day of pickup.
